	INSWING	SLIDER	OUTSWING
PROS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Largest egress opening • Fast and easy enter or egress • Optimum for partial above grade window installations • Multiple window positions for fresh air • Unobstructed view • Design provides more security • Minimum size window well for inswing windows are 42" x 36" with a Life-Step Ladder 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application for wider window installations • Less expensive than Outswing • Open window doesn't interfere with egress • Minimum size window well for slider windows are 42" x 36" with a Life-Step Ladder 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application for taller window installations • Unobstructed view • Recommended minimum size window well for casement windows is 50" x 36" with a Corner-Step Ladder
CONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Window swings inward 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Overlapping panels obstruct view 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Crank out-swing takes time to open • Window opens into well, can block egress
