

What is "Egress"?


A "means of egress" is simply a basement window that provides an additional way out in case of emergency.

Window opening must be a minimum 5.7 sq. ft. and the egress well space must be a minimum 9 sq. ft.

A Life-Step[™] or Corner Step[™] egress ladder is required by code if the window-well is 44" deep (or more).

Add a Safe-T-View Cover™ egress window well cover to protect for fall hazard.

Egress Window Styles



Recommended minimum size areawell for a casement style window is 50° x 36° with a Corner-StepTM ladder.

Minimum size window well for both a slider and inswing style window are 42° x 36° with a Life-StepTM ladder.


*Check with your local building inspector to verify your code requirements before ordering or installing any areawall.


